

## Dialectic Literature : Final Project : June 2009

1. Choose a main character from a book we read in class this year ( for example : Alice from *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* )

**OR**

Choose the author of a book that we read ( for example: H.G.Wells Author of *The Invisible Man* )

2. You will be dramatizing that character or that author in two ways :
  - a. in your **appearance** : in other words you will dress like that character would have dressed – considering the physical, temporal, and cultural setting of the story;  
**OR**  
You will dress like the author- considering the time and place in which the author lived.
  - b. a **spoken** representation :  
If your choice was a character - you will tell a story (your choice) from that character's experiences within the pages of the book ( for example : "Alice" might tell about the croquet game) The idea is that you will **BE** the character and tell the story from your point of view.  
If your choice was an author - you will tell something about your own life .. in your own words ( for example: Rudyard Kipling might relate something about his life in India )

In either case you will need to write out your spoken part – It should be at least **one page in length – but no more than two in pages in total**. It should be written from a **first person point of view** ( in the character's/author's own words ).

Please e-mail me as soon as possible with your choice ( #1) as well as with your idea for a story for the spoken part of your representation - you **MUST** have your choices approved by me before you proceed any further.

After you are given approval you should write out your spoken part and bring it to class on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
